OSHP to Produce *The Hobbit*

OSHP is excited to announce its "winter" production! In April we will be presenting an adaptation of J.R.R. Tolkien's classic tale, *The Hobbit*. This fast-paced, one-act adventure play journeys through the exciting world of Middle Earth. The main character, Bilbo Baggins, loves good stories and soon finds himself on a quest that takes him through mountains, forests, bogs, and caves.

Director Chris Phistry notes that there are roles for over 20 actors along with additional "extra" roles. ALL AGES of actors are needed and there are roles for both males and females. Many roles are "gender-neutral." Jeanne O'Malley will be producing the show and Kate Nipko will be Stage Manager. We are hoping for a big turnout at auditions, which will be held in early February.

Performances of *The Hobbit* will be held April 7-10 at the Prairie View Elementary School Little Theatre. This is the same theatre in which we have produced many of our winter plays in the past. We have specially chosen these performance dates to assist our "student" actors. The final week of rehearsal, when rehearsals often run the latest, will be during Spring Break, so students and parents will not have to worry about getting ready for school the next morning.

Historic Truss Makes First Appearance

OSHP has a great history reaching back over 20 years. Talk to any "veteran" of OSHP and each will have his or her own story to tell about a production or an event. Our theatre history helps shape who we are and connects us as a group.

For those of you who have been around for awhile, you might remember our production of *Pippin* in 1996. Kurt Schnabel was the designer for the show and had a fabulous idea for a lighting truss which would encircle the stage on the floor of the old OHS Cafetorium (a room which itself contains enough history for its own book!). Jace Nichols, who directed the show, had created beautiful stage pictures based on the truss to help tell the story. With the help of a number of workers, the truss was created and was ready to be used in the show. Unfortunately, due to circumstances beyond our control, it was never used in the production and has, since that time, resided in our storage space on Market Street.

This season, however, the truss found a new temporary home. Strollers Theatre, a group with which many OSHP members work, incorporated the truss into its set design of its recent play *Saint Joan*. While not in its original shape, the piece looked great on stage and one can only imagine the powerful presence it might have had in *Pippin*.

Fundraising Goal Set

Thanks to everyone who participated in our Individual Shining Stars program last year. Your contributions help us offset the many expenses beyond productions that we have throughout the year.

The board has organized a special fundraising committee to help address our growing need for money. Last year, group expenses totaled over \$8250 and expenses will increase this year with our larger shed and need to purchase some new equipment. The board also recognizes the value of people's time and hopes to create a plan where we can maximize our income, while limiting the amount of time spent on fundraising projects.

The more money we can collect from our Shining Stars program, the less work we all have to do on other fundraising. If each member could consider adding \$25-40 to their contribution, we could eliminate the need for some of our other fundraisers.
