Please read carefully prior to filling out the information on the attached form – thank you!

- **PHONE NUMBER:** We are asking for the child and parent mobile phone numbers. These numbers will be used as the primary contact when we need to reach you on the day of a rehearsal.
- **EMAIL:** Please give us the email address you wish to receive information at (such as rehearsal schedule, etc.) Also give us a parent's email so that they can stay informed as well.
- **PERMISSION:** Auditioners under the age of 18 must have a parent/guardian's permission to be in the show. Please realize we may speak with your parent/guardian regarding this when casting the show. There is a separate parent/guardian permission form that they must fill out.
- **POSSIBLY PROVIDE:** In this production, performers may be asked to provide basic costume items such as shoes and tights from their personal wardrobes.
- **EXPERIENCE:** Under "Experience" just give us a little information about your background. We want to know what experience you have that <u>best</u> represents your abilities and strengths specifically in regards to this show. If you have a theatre resume, you may attach it, <u>but we still want you to fill out the "Experience" section.</u>
- **CONFLICTS:** Conflicts are something we have to live with, but it will help the production if you can be <u>as complete as possible</u> in listing your outside commitments. In the conflict grid, <u>circle the times</u> when you have other commitments. Getting a complete picture of conflicts will help us to cast the show and schedule for the best efficiency. We generally intend to rehearse Wednesday through Friday 4:45-7:15pm and Sundays from 10am-2pm. Rehearsals the week of the show will be longer. If you have a conflict with the required rehearsals and performances we cannot cast you in this show.
- **IN ORDER TO BE CAST:** Availability on June 9, 10, 11, and 12 (evenings) and <u>all 3 performances</u> (June 13-15) is required if you wish to be cast in the show.
